STEWARDSHIP REFLECTIONS



TAKE IT LIKE A GIRL

It is unsettling to ponder it, but there are still cultures and homes where it is considered a letdown to conceive a daughter. This disappointment was historically bred by the practical concerns of Kings who needed heirs and families for whom dowries were a financial burden. Modern societies still denigrate women and feminine traits in blatant and subtle ways, like objectifying women's bodies and mocking anyone who "hits like a girl."

The angel declares that Mary is blessed, but also that all women are implicitly favored as vessels of divine life in the world. Today we affirm daughters everywhere as precious in both divine and human sight. We celebrate the strength, determination, and courage of women, but also gifts that are too often dismissed as weakness: empathy, intuition, emotion, kindness, cooperation, and gentleness. Mary teaches us that when life presents challenges or divine calls of duty, we should "take it like a girl."

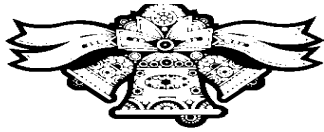

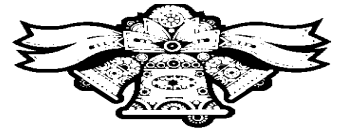
