The Sanctuary Lamp



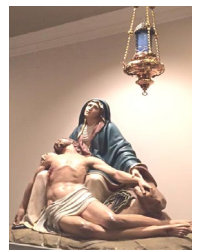

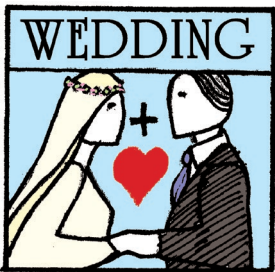

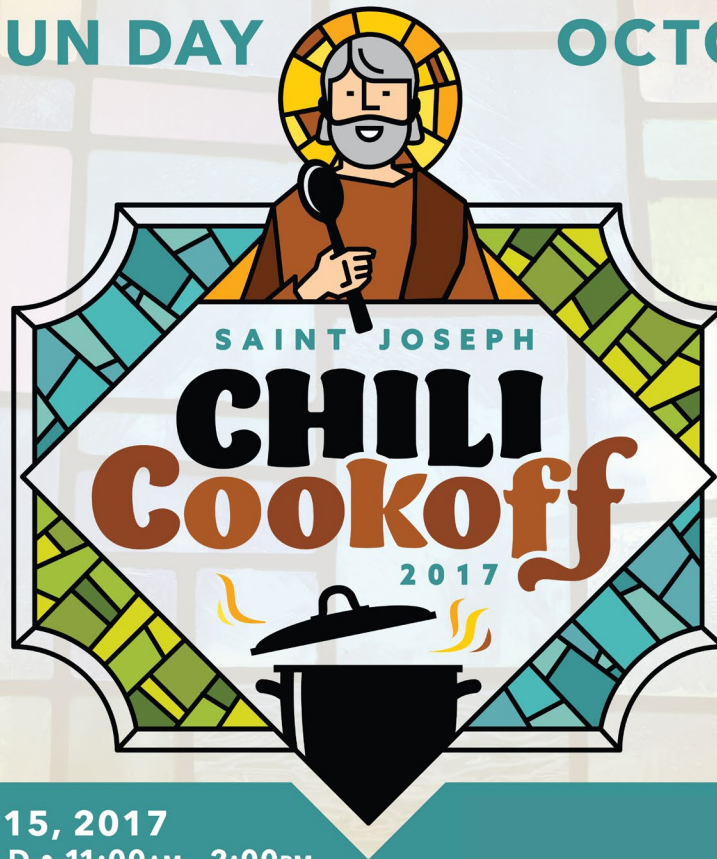
