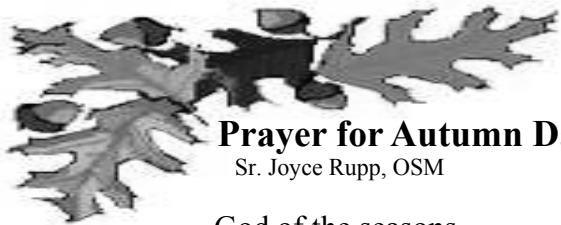


Bishop's Services Appeal

carried into the future.

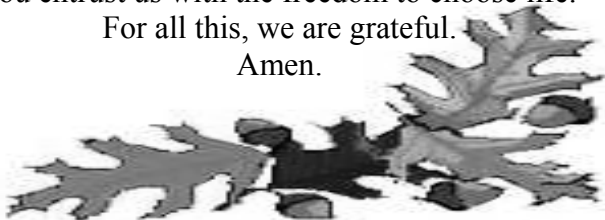
We yearn for insight and vision.
