Reflecting on God's Word

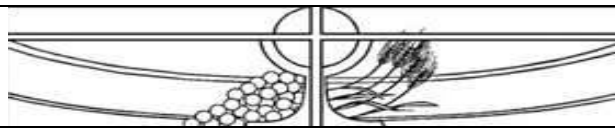
