“Well, I don’t know,” says the other, “but certainly we will see mother and she will take care of us.”

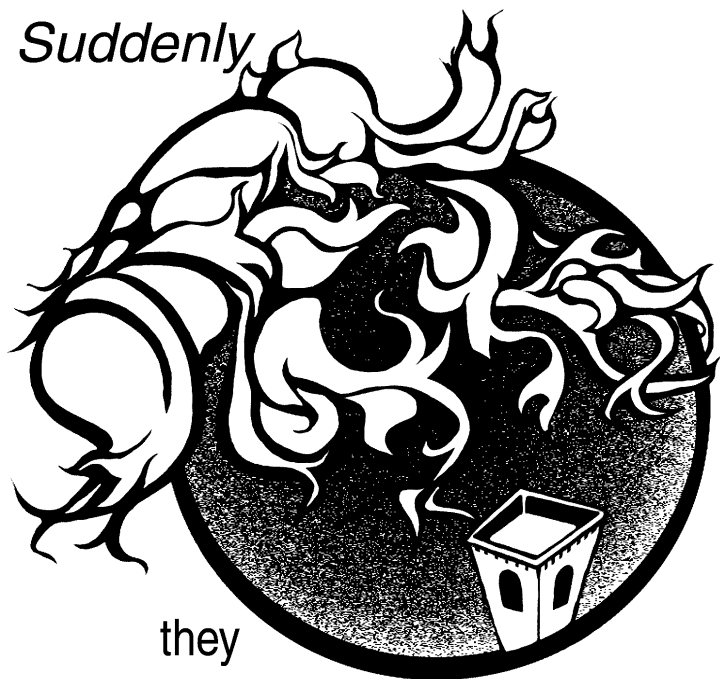
“Mother? You believe in mother? Where is she now?”

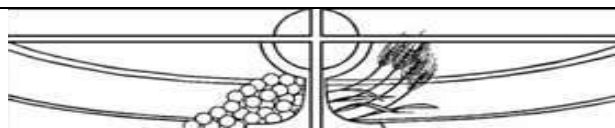
A Graduate’s Prayer
