Heavenly Father, you have given us the model of life in the holy family of Nazareth. Help us to make our family another Nazareth where

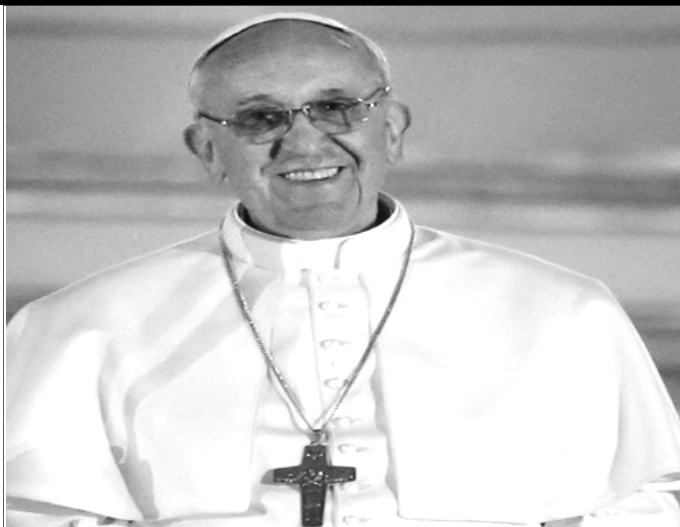
