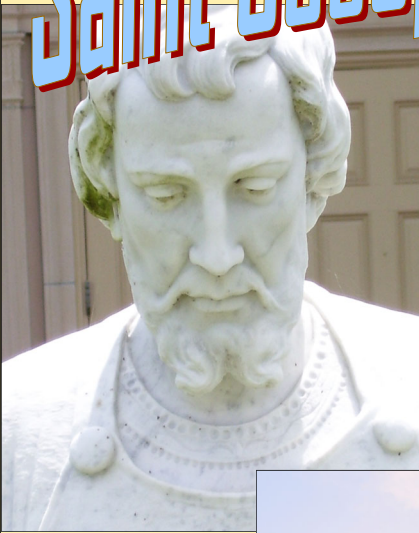

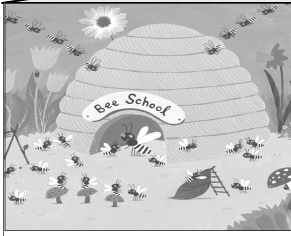

### Catholics Returning Home Program Jan 13 - Feb 17, 2014

The Catholics Returning Home program is designed to reach-out and invite non-practicing, inactive Catholics to return "Home to the Catholic Church" and resume the practice of their faith.

*"Come to me all you who are weary and find life burdensome and I will refresh you." Matt 11:28*

Catholics Returning Home provides a positive context for inactive Catholics to hear this personal call. Coming home to this personal relationship with God through the Church is a challenging step for most people who have been inactive for any period of years. This program provides a welcoming space for Catholics who have not been connected to a faith community where:

- Personal stories of pain and hurt can be told
- Participation in the worshipping Community is made to be very comfortable
- Concerns and questions can be met or directed to the appropriate people
- Acceptance and understanding are modeled after Our Lord Jesus Christ

The topics of each session are:

- Week 1 Welcome, Overview, Sharing of Stories
- Week 2 Returning Catholics, Why they leave? Why they return? Discussion and Sharing
- Week 3 The Church Today
- Week 4 Walking through the Mass
- Week 5 Sacrament of Reconciliation
- Week 6 Not the End but the Beginning – The Creed: What Catholics Believe

This initial six-week program begins Monday January 13, 2014 and ends Monday February 17, 2014 and will be held in the St. Pius X Annex Building, Meeting Room, 201 E. Bayou Pkwy, Lafayette

### TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

By Candlemas, forty days after Christmas, February 2, the season of Christ's coming has depleted our candle supply. Soon, the parish will order a new paschal candle from a catalogue or candlemaker, or in some communities, wax will be collected to be melted and molded. Last year's paschal candle shows the wear and tear of summer heat, or many funerals or baptisms.

Paschal candles have been around since at least the fourth century, when Constantine's biographer Eusebius reported that the night of the sacred vigil was "transformed into the brilliancy of day, by lighting throughout the city pillars of wax, while burning lamps in every place so that the splendor of this night was brighter than the brightest daylight."

Light was a precious commodity in the ancient world, and this lavish use of precious beeswax was a sign of the Christian's call to bear Christ's light into the world's darkness. In a pre-electric age, a whole city aglow from the paschal flame must have been a glorious sight, and a reminder to every baptized Christian of our vocation to "be the light of the world."
