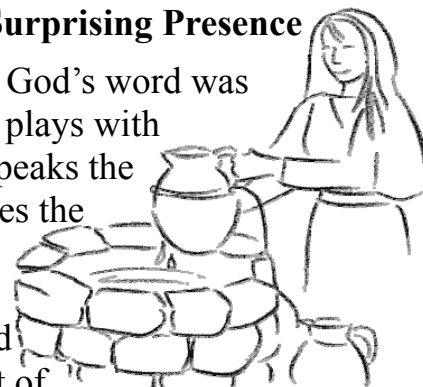

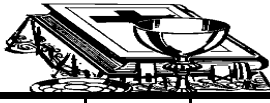
God's Surprising Presence

For the Hebrews, God's word was a fountain. Jesus plays with the image as he speaks the word that quenches the woman's thirst.

That such an outpouring should come in the midst of



an onerous chore might be the equivalent of someone today trekking to the grocery store and finding enlightenment among the canned soups. The woman is responding to a driving, physical need: she simply wants to fill her bucket and get home before it gets any hotter. She is completely surprised by an encounter which changes her life. The event reinforces the recurrent scriptural idea that splendid events do intersect the daily routine - at the well, not the synagogue; in the office, not the church; in the kitchen, not the temple. It's good news that supposedly "unhallowed" ground is sacred.
