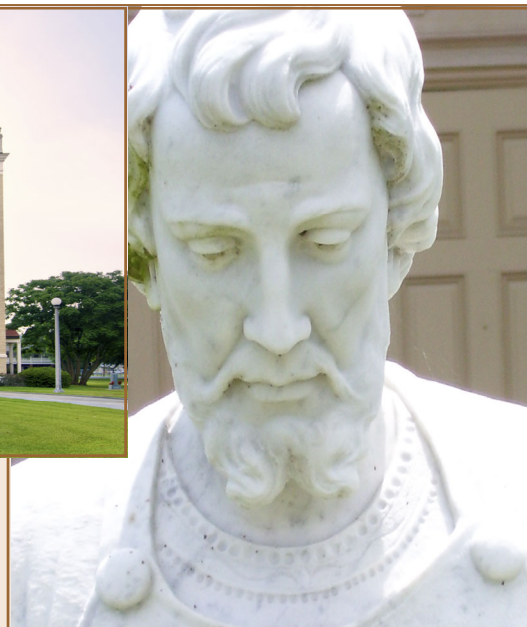

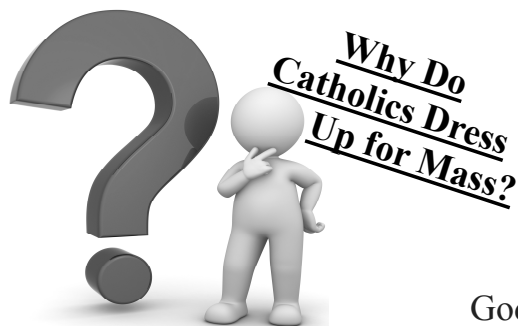

Scripture invites us to unwrap some of the "gifts"
that we bless and receive in our Eucharistic meal.
Christ shares the gift of himself in the word, the cup,
and the loaf. Like Dean's family, we in the

another in our sharing of the Body and Blood of
Christ. The living, breathing Body of Christ in the
community nourishes the life of Christ in each of us
when we sit down together at the Eucharistic table.
