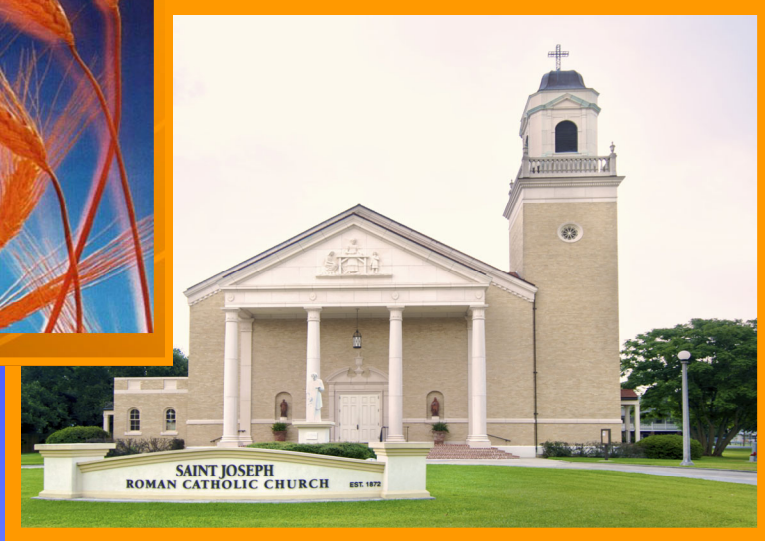

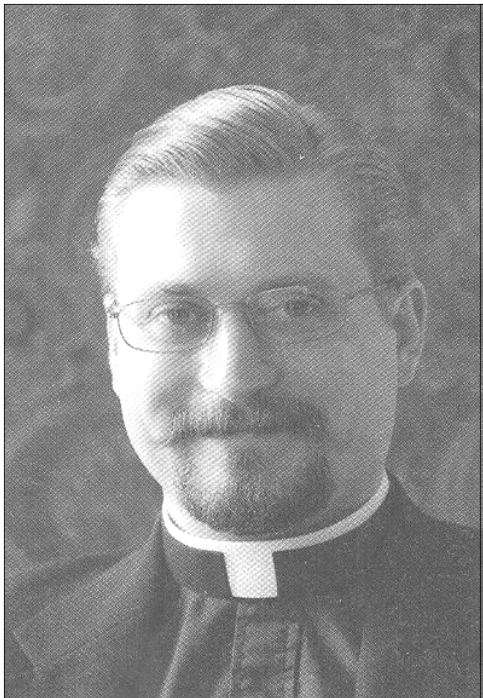

THE KINGDOM 'S HIDDEN WORK

Jesus says the kingdom is like the yeast a woman works into a batch of flour, where it leavens the mass, filling it with bubbles of life. Like the mustard seed, yeast starts very small and grows in a completely natural way. But there is a human factor here, the woman using the yeast to make bread. And the yeast does not just grow; it acts on something else to transform it entirely, changing the flour and water from a kind of sticky paste into life-giving bread.

So the kingdom does not just happen out in the world somewhere, but works within us, like yeast, often at the hands of another, indeed often at the hands of a woman. It transforms who we are, our lives and souls, from the inside out.

A Prayer for Sight & Service

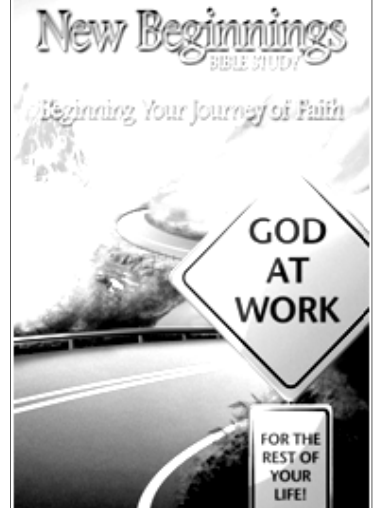
