Children learn liturgical behavior by copying you, so sing, pray and voice the responses.

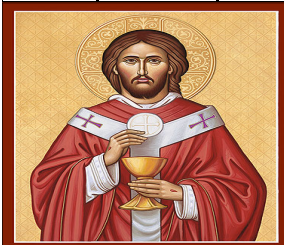
If you have to leave Mass with your children, feel free to do so, but please come back.
