This Sunday we observe "Priesthood Sunday," a day set aside each year to highlight the centrality of the priest in parish life. "Priesthood Sunday" is an initiative of the USA Council of Serra International, an organization of lay men and women dedicated to promoting and supporting vocations to the priesthood. "Priesthood Sunday" gives us an opportunity to remember the men who have served us faithfully and helped us to grow into more perfect disciples of Christ and to thank and support our priests. But this day also has its roots in a much different experience that some have faced in recent years: walking into a parish Church on a Sunday morning and finding no priest there at all.

One afternoon, I was waiting for Mass to start at St. John's and there was no priest. Some nuns were visiting from New York and they said they didn't have a priest in any of their parishes anymore, and that Eucharistic services were common. I thought, "What would it be like if there were no priests?" And I asked myself, "What are you doing about it?" — Elizabeth Shrier, Serra Club of Omaha, NE

"Priesthood Sunday" gives us the opportunity to ask ourselves two questions: "What does the priesthood mean to me, in my own experience of Christ and his Church?" and "What am I doing about it . . . ?"

We have been blessed here at St. Joseph's with many good and faithful priests (I love to hear stories about Msgr. Hurbert Lerschen, Fr. Ben Drapeau, Fr. Gene Tremie, etc., and what these men have meant to you). We need to give thanks to God for all that we receive through the ministry of his priests. But more than this, we need to remember that a priest is God's answer to the prayers of the people: "The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few; so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest" (Lk 10:2). In a certain sense, we get what we ask for, and if we sometimes feel we have received so little, it is because we have not asked with confidence and persistence. "Amen, amen, I say to you, whatever you ask the Father in my name he will give you. Until now you have not asked anything in my name; ask and you will receive, so that your joy may be complete" (Jn 16:23b-24). The best way we can promote vocations to the priesthood, especially from our own parish, is simply to ask for them, and then to support them as they are given. To this end, we are bringing back the tradition of the "Vocations Chalice." Beginning this Sunday, at the end of 10:00 a. m. mass, and each week thereafter, the chalice will be entrusted to a family. It is to be set in a place of honor in the home, where the family can gather daily to pray for vocations to the priesthood. This is a simple gesture, but one that carries much weight and can bear much fruit for our Church. 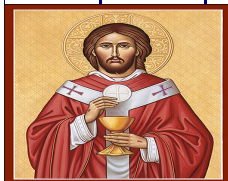

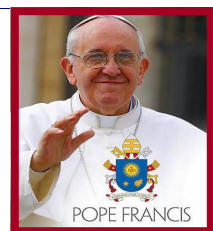
