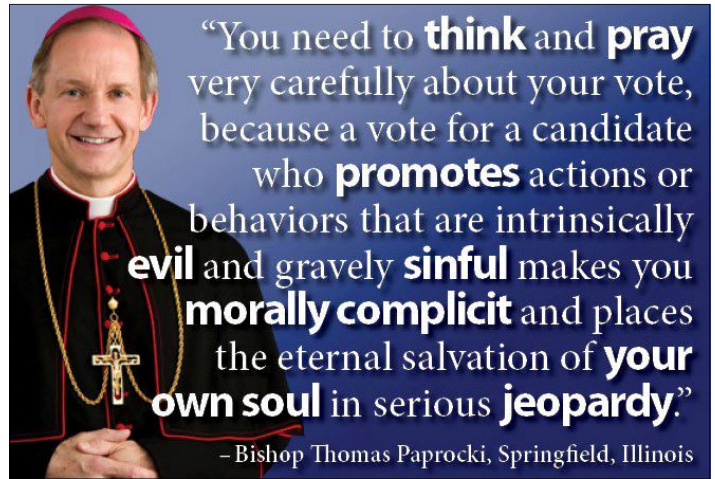

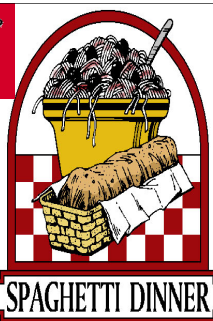

The Feast Of All Souls

The Feast of All Souls is an important celebration. It is a reminder to us of our own mortality. It is an opportunity for us to remember all those who we have loved and have gone before us in death. But much more than these, this feast day, paired together with the Feast of All Saints, is a powerful sign of our faith in the communion of saints, a doctrine that we confess in the Apostles' Creed. What does this mean, the "communion of saints?" It is the Church. It means that because of Christ I am forever joined to you and you to me. It means that you and I share the same life—like two babies in the same womb—that you and I, who have known one another here, even if only in passing, will meet again. It means that, no matter what happens to me in life, I have a family that awaits me.

Whoever believes in the communion of saints sees death differently. If we believe that we are joined together in this permanent bond in Christ, then we cannot forget the dead. We cannot ignore them. Because we believe in the communion of saints, we accompany one another through life. And we accompany one another even through death. Death cannot separate what Christ has joined together. This is why we pray for the dead. This is why we trust in the intercession of the saints. Let us confess our faith in the unity of Christ's Body as we accompany our brothers and sisters who have gone before us, both in our prayers and affection for them, and in our trust in their intercession for us.

by one we go as they have gone.*

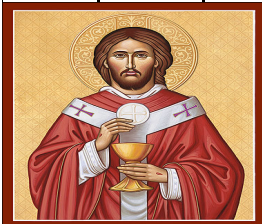

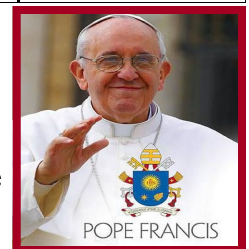
