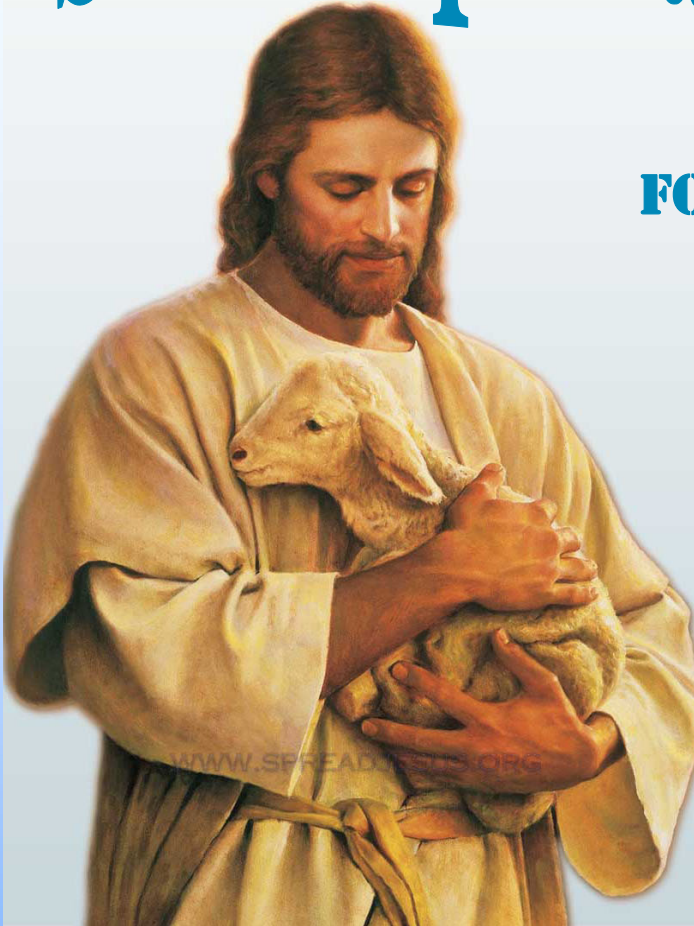

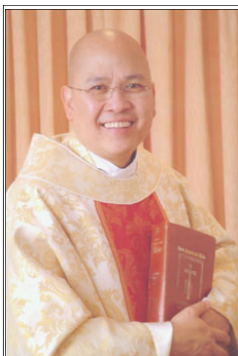

All supplies and donations are needed by May 22nd.

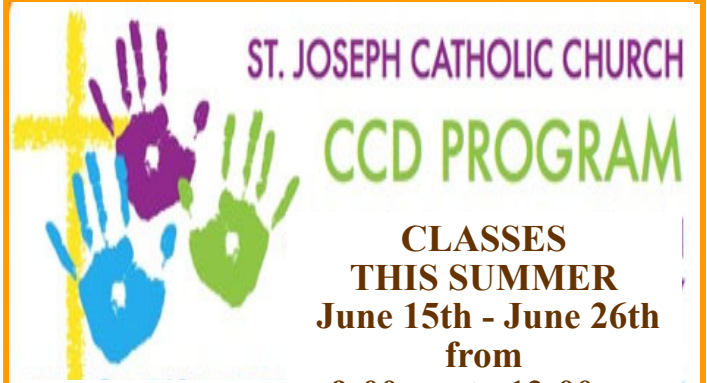

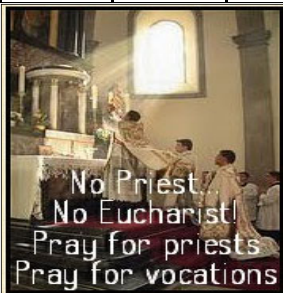
