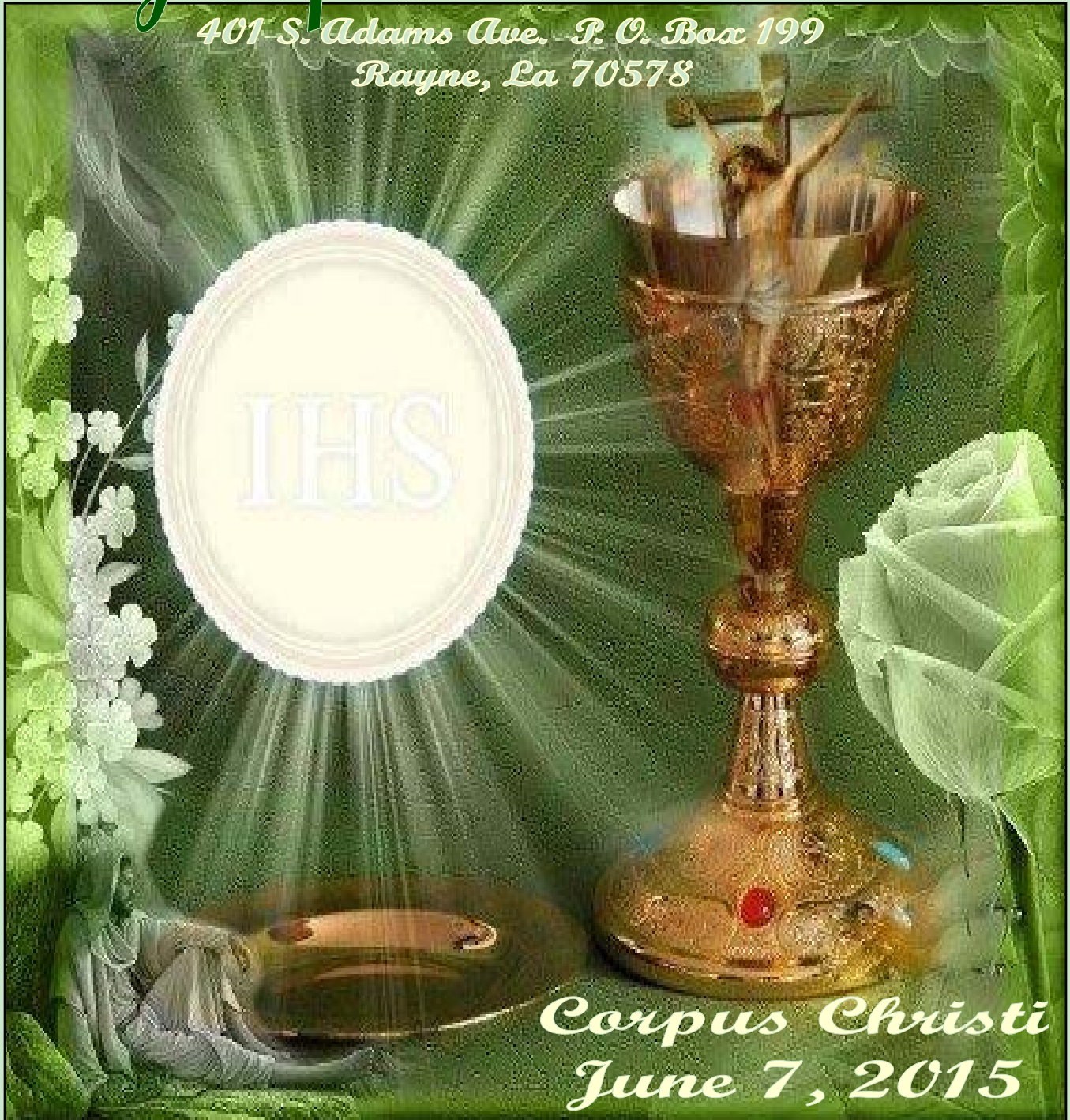

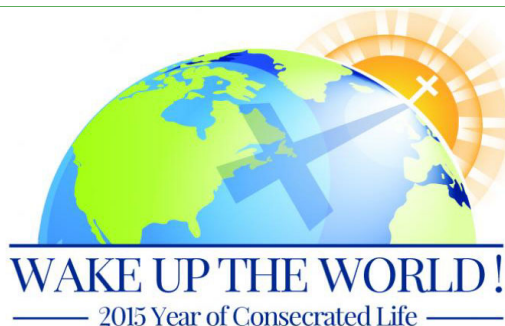
**Sacrament of Reconciliation:** 30 minutes prior to Mass or any other time by appointment.

## Year of Consecrated Life: Evangelical Poverty

Throughout the “Year of Consecrated Life” we consider the great gift that religious consecration is to the Church. This summer we look more closely at the three evangelical counsels: poverty, chastity, and obedience, which characterize consecrated life. First, poverty: That discipleship requires poverty is clear from the Gospel itself: “If you would be perfect, go, sell what you possess and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, follow me” (Mtt 19:21). Consecration is a total commitment to Jesus and his Kingdom. Poverty—freely choosing not to own things—is an act of “radical readiness” for the coming of that Kingdom. In other words, because we are not filled up and concerned with our own possessions, we are ready to be filled by God and the works that He gives to us to accomplish. Poverty means “using without possessing.” A consecrated person may very well own something (a house, a car, a computer) but places everything at the disposal of Jesus and his Kingdom.

Poverty looks different in different forms of consecrated life. There are those who embrace a vow of poverty and own or buy nothing whatsoever, using only what is given to them. Others do not take a specific vow of poverty, but live a communal life where everything is owned in community and used for the good of all. Still others live poorly for the sake of the poor whom they serve. And even those who live their consecration in the world as consecrated virgins or widows live out Gospel poverty as they await the coming of the Bridegroom. The poverty we see in consecrated life is a tangible reminder of the Gospel: “Do not worry about your life, what you will eat, or about your body, what you will wear. . . But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be given you besides” (Mtt 6:26, 33).

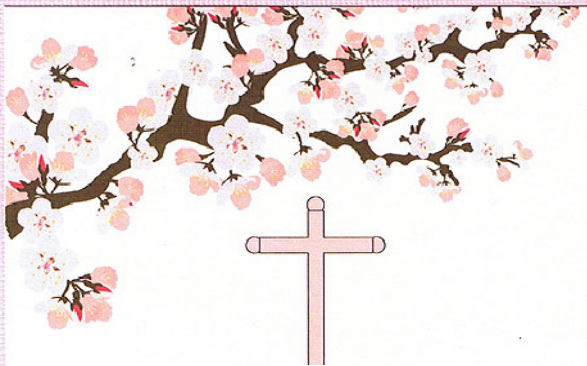

# 2015 VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL



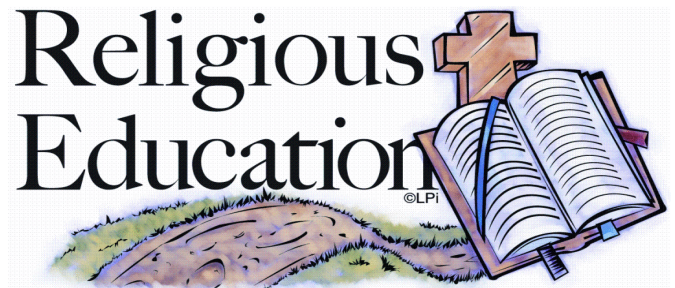
2015 Vacation Bible School was a huge success with over 300 in attendance.

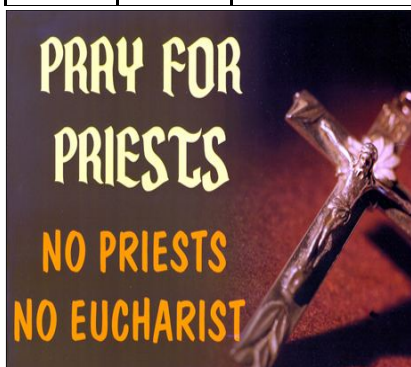
