Using Your Phone for Lent

Ever notice how many people give up social media, playing phone games, or just limit their time phone-browsing mindlessly for Lent? All of these are wonderful penances if you find yourself putting any of these things before God, taking away precious prayer time.


On the other hand, have you ever thought of using your phone for good this Lent? Whether you can't bring yourself to give up your phone or you just want a good, positive penance this Lent, here are seven ways to use your phone for Lent:

- 1. Text a different person every single day to affirm them and ask how you can pray for them.
- 2.Set alarms to remind you to pray throughout the day.
- 3.Download the Laudate app and pray the Liturgy of the Hours.
- 4.Read scripture every day and then post a reflection on Face book, Twitter, or even Snapchat, spreading God's word.
- 5.Set three reminders a day, spaced evenly. At this time, reflect on your day so far, staying mindful of God in your daily life.
- 6.Delete one song in your library (or on a playlist) that probably shouldn't be there. Listen to worship music, praying through it, instead.
