The Sanctuary Lamp



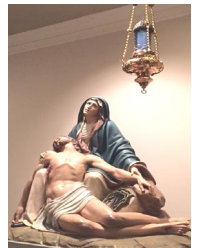

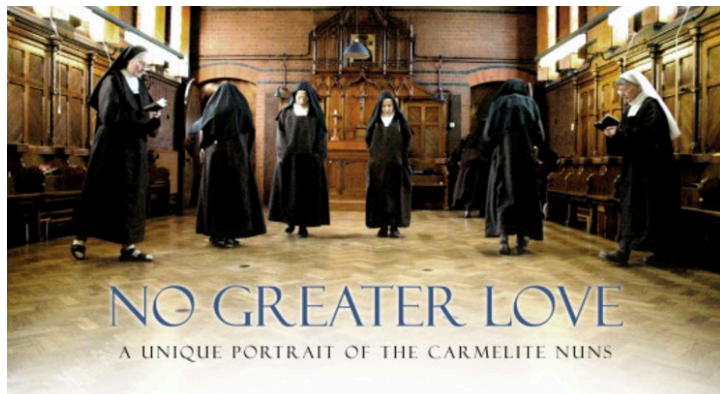

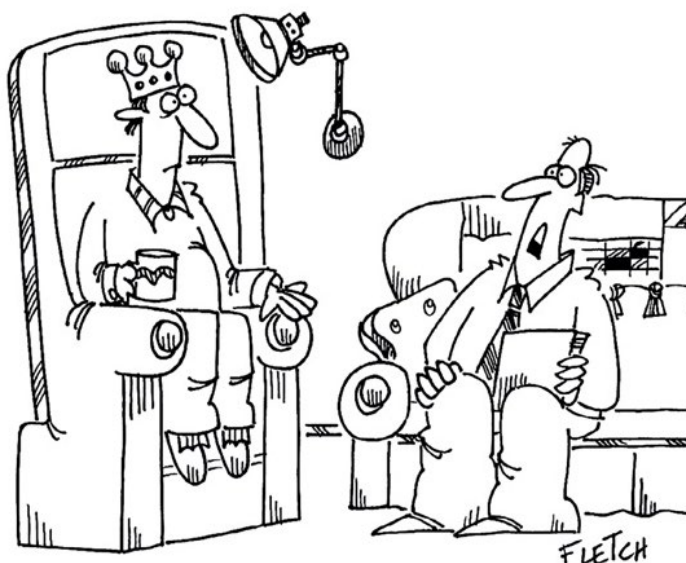
Spring Blood Drive
