

St. Mark the Evangelist (1st c.) was born to Jewish parents living in Libya in North Africa, later settling in Cana of Galilee not far from Jerusalem. Mark became one of the 70 disciples of Jesus and the author of the Gospel that bears his name. Most of what we know about his life and missionary activity is recorded in the New Testament. St. Mark is the patron of lawyers and prisoners. His feast day is April 25.
