The Sanctuary Lamp



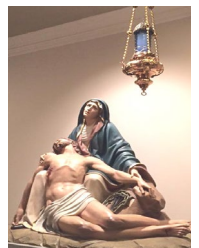

Adult Confirmation Class

St. Joseph's Parish will be hosting adult confirmation classes beginning October 9th for baptized Catholics who have already received their First Communion and are over the age of 18.

This 6 week course, taught by Fr. Kevin Bordelon and Fr. Christopher Cambre, will meet on Tuesday evenings starting at 6:00pm at Rayne Catholic Elementary. The Adult Confirmation ceremony will be held at St. Joseph's Church on Sunday, November 25th (the feast of Christ the King) during the 10am Mass.

In Catholicism there are three Sacraments of Initiation by which we become full members of the Church. This course is tailored to individuals who received their first two Sacraments of Baptism and First Communion, but for whatever reason were not Confirmed.

Confirmation is the Sacrament instituted in the very beginning of the Church by Jesus Christ when He sent the Holy Spirit to descend upon the Apostles at Pentecost. Confirmation perfects our baptismal grace, it roots us more deeply in our relationship with the Father, it incorporates us more firmly into Christ, it strengthens our bond with the Church, it associates us more closely with the Church's mission, and it helps us to bear witness to the Christian faith in words accompanied by deeds. Being confirmed is also a requirement for participating as a sponsor (Godparent) in baptisms.

If you have a concern regarding your ability to be confirmed due to being married outside of the Church and needing your marriage blessed, or if you are in need to petition for an annulment from a prior marriage, we still invite you to begin this confirmation process. You can still take part in the classes now and be confirmed at a later date once any marriage issues have been resolved.

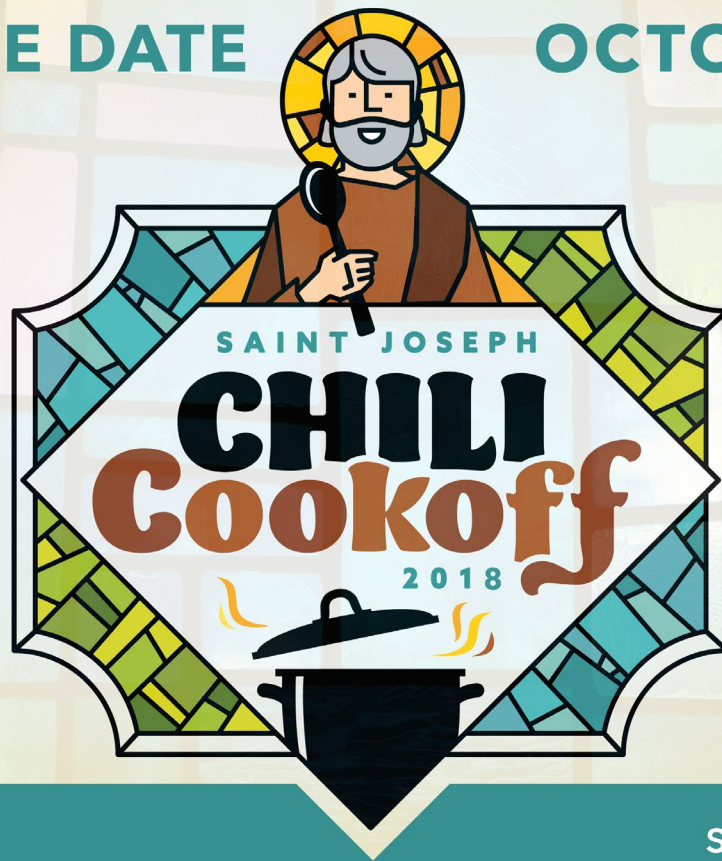
