## The Sanctuary Lamp



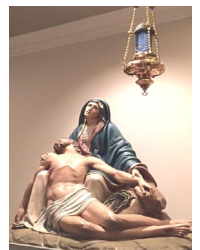

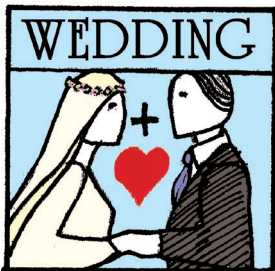

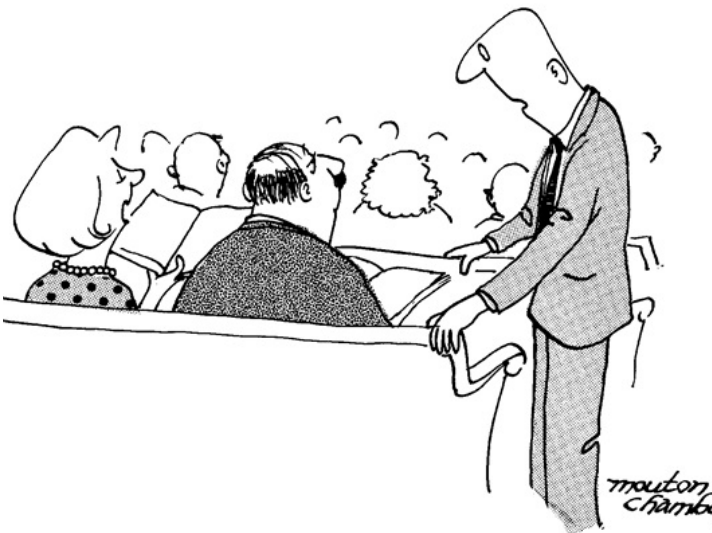
