## The Sanctuary Lamp



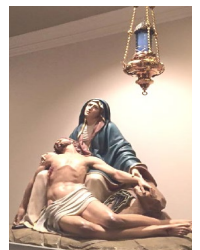

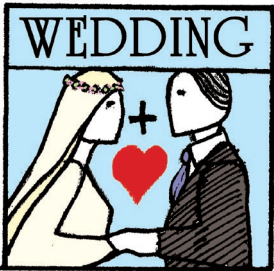


## Annual Farmers Mass

### *Ever consider direct deposit or scheduled monthly credit card offerings?*

The biggest factor seems to be most of us are in the "Vacation Mode" as we certainly need the break from daily routine to refresh our spirits and strengthen/renew our family bonds.

One way you can remain consistent with your offertory giving is through direct deposits or even rack up mileage points for your next family vacation by setting up monthly credit card transactions.

### *This is how direct deposits work:*

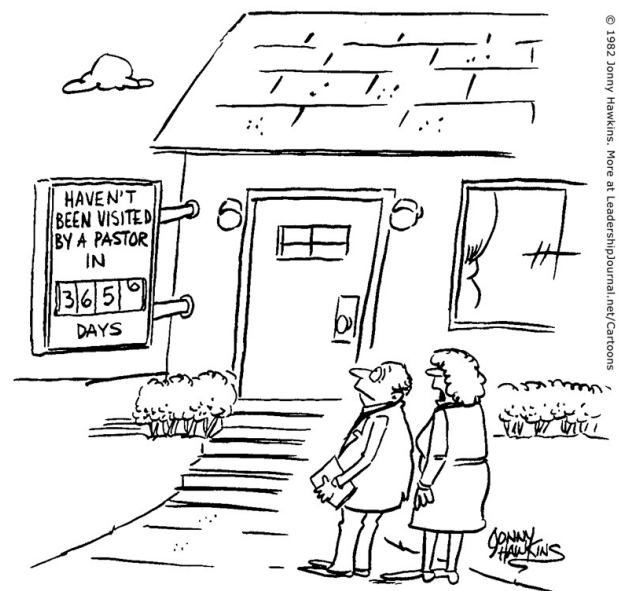
- You complete a "Direct Deposit Authorization" form (this gives us permission to debit your checking or savings account for the amount and on the date you specify)
- We make withdrawals on the 2nd and 16th of each month (when the 2nd or 16th falls on a weekend or banking holiday the withdrawal will occur the next banking day)
- You determine the amount and frequency of your donations

### *For credit card donations:*

- You simply fill out your information on the parish website and the amount you would like to give monthly and you are all set.
