### Anointing of the Sick



### This is how direct deposits work:

- -We make withdrawals on the 2nd and 16th of each month (when the 2nd or 16th falls on a weekend or banking holiday the withdrawal will occur the next banking day)
- -You determine the amount and frequency of your donations


### For credit card donations:
