

Ever consider direct deposit or scheduled monthly credit card offerings?

This is how direct deposits work:

- -You complete a "Direct Deposit Authorization" form (this gives us permission to debit your checking or savings account for the amount and on the date you
- -We make withdrawals on the 2nd and 16th of each month (when the 2nd or 16th falls on a weekend or banking holiday the withdrawal will occur the next banking day)
- -You determine the amount and frequency of your donations

For credit card donations:

- You simply fill out your information on the parish website and the amount you would like to give monthly and you are all set.
