The Sanctuary Lamp



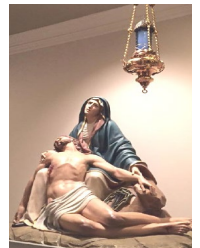

Feeding our Faith is offered free of charge so please come and join us as together we build up the Kingdom of God through fellowship and formation.

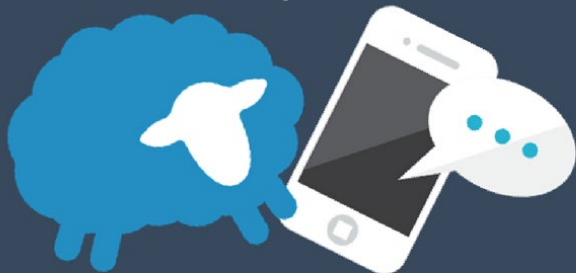

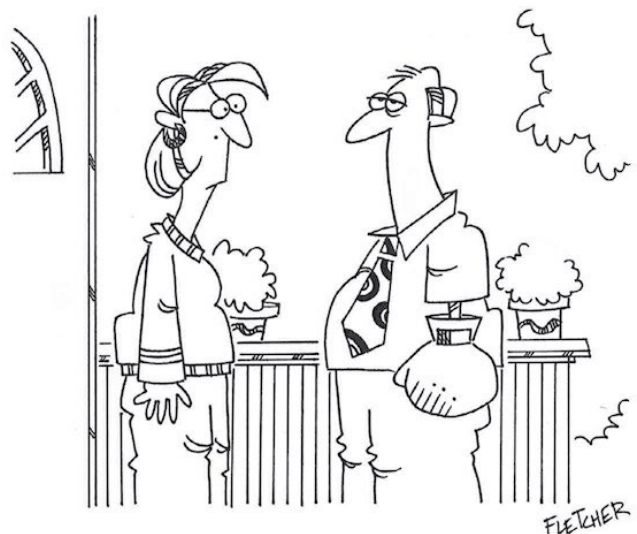

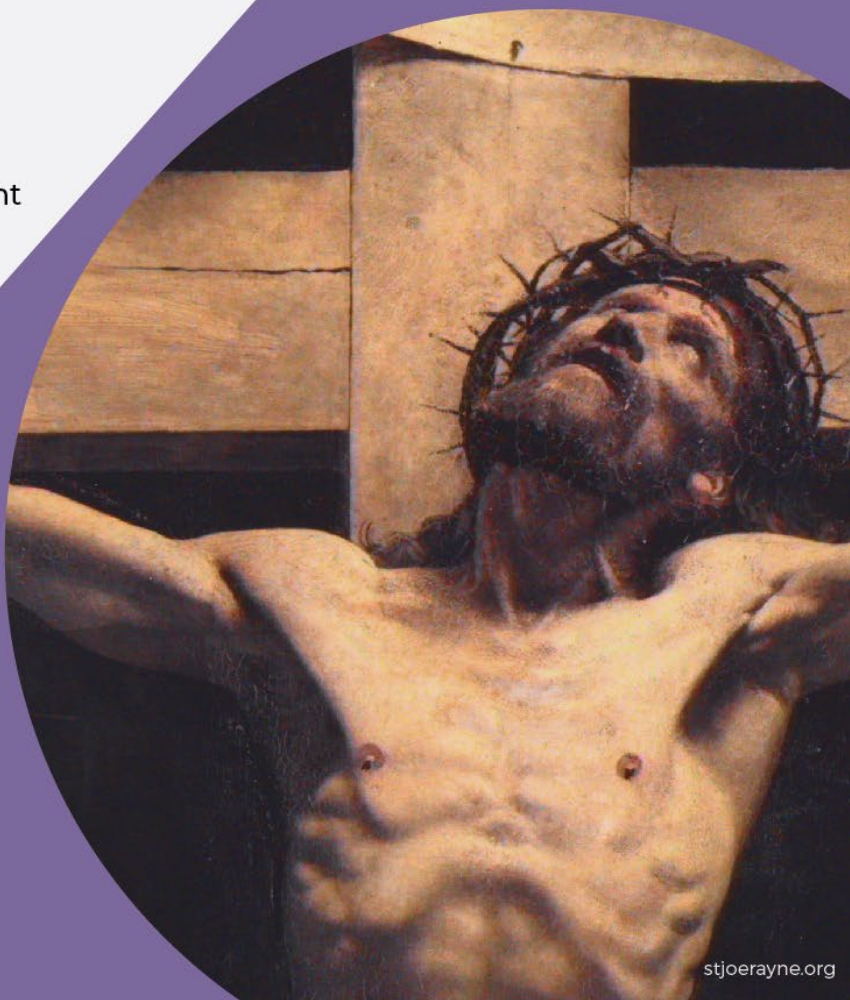
