
Faith Formation

This is an interactive platform that engages students and parents through sacred art, Catholic devotionals, lives of the saints, and effective discussion on life application.

Pope Francis has granted a Plenary Indulgence throughout the Year of St. Joseph to all Catholics of the Diocese of Lafayette. This indulgence may be gained by visiting one of the 13 St. Joseph Churches in the Diocese of Lafayette on either the first Saturday or the 19th day of the month and there participating in prayer held in St. Joseph's honor OR at least for a fitting period of time offering humble prayer to God for perseverance in the Christian life, for vocations to the priesthood and religious life, and for the defense of the family, concluding with the Lord's Prayer, the Creed,

and invoking the Most Blessed Virgin Mary and St. Joseph,

Patron of the Catholic Church.

This is a great opportunity of grace that Pope Francis is offering to us which signifies that this Year of St. Joseph is a milestone of God's Grace that we must honor with our own faith. The usual conditions for an indulgence must also be fulfilled. Individuals must be baptized and in a state of grace. Individuals must have the general intention of gaining the indulgence. Individuals must receive Holy Communion, preferably on the same day if possible. Individuals must worthily celebrate the Sacrament of Confession within 20 days (before or after) of performing the indulgenced act, although preferably immediately before or after. Individuals must manifest his/her communion with the Church by praying for the intentions of the Pope with (1) the Apostles Creed, (2) the "Our Father," and "Hail Mary."

Year of St. Joseph Devotionals

The chaplet of Saint Joseph rosary is divided into fifteen groups of four beads consisting of one white and three purple beads. On the white bead, which symbolizes Saint Joseph's purity, announce one of the mysteries of the Rosary, and say two Hail Marys on that bead. On the purple bead, which symbolizes his saintly piety, say the prayer on each bead in that group, "Praised and blessed be Jesus, Mary and Joseph!"

The Saint Joseph Chaplet Rosary is said as follows:

1st Purple - Praised and blessed be Jesus, Mary and Joseph! 1st White - The Annunciation (say 2 Hail Marys) group of 3 Purple - Praised and blessed be Jesus, Mary and Joseph!

2nd White - The Visitation (say 2 Hail Marys) group of 3 Purple - Praised and blessed be Jesus, Mary and Joseph!

3rd White - The Nativity (say 2 Hail Marys) group of 3 Purple - Praised and blessed be Jesus, Mary and Joseph!

4th White - The Presentation in the Temple (say 2 Hail Marys) group of 3 Purple - Praised and blessed be Jesus, Mary and Joseph!

5th White - The Finding of Our Lord in the Temple (say 2 Hail Marys) group of 3 Purple - Praised and blessed be Jesus, Mary and Joseph!

6th White - The Agony in the Garden (say 2 Hail Marys) group of 3 Purple - Praised and blessed be Jesus, Mary and Joseph!

7th White - The Scourging (say 2 Hail Marys) group of 3 Purple - Praised and blessed be Jesus, Mary and Joseph!

8th White - The Crowing with Thorns (say 2 Hail Marys) group of 3 Purple - Praised and blessed be Jesus, Mary and Joseph!

9th White - The Carrying of the Cross (say 2 Hail Marys) group of 3 Purple - Praised and blessed be Jesus, Mary and Joseph!

10th White - The Crucifixion (say 2 Hail Marys) group of 3 Purple - Praised and blessed be Jesus, Mary and Joseph!

11th White - The Resurrection (say 2 Hail Marys) group of 3 Purple - Praised and blessed be Jesus, Mary and Joseph!

12th White - The Ascension (say 2 Hail Marys) group of 3 Purple - Praised and blessed be Jesus, Mary and Joseph!

13th White - The Descent of the Holy Spirit (say 2 Hail Marys) group of 3 Purple - Praised and blessed be Jesus, Mary and Joseph!

14th White - The Assumption (say 2 Hail Marys) group of 3 Purple - Praised and blessed be Jesus, Mary and Joseph!

15th White - The Coronation of the Blessed Virgin (say 2 Hail Marys) group of 3 Purple - Praised and blessed be Jesus, Mary and Joseph!

End the chaplet with the following prayers:

V. Pray for us, O holy St. Joseph.

R. That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

Let us pray:

O God, Who has predestined St. Joseph from all eternity for the service of Thine Eternal Son and His Blessed Mother, and made him worthy to be the spouse of this Blessed Virgin and the foster father of Thy Son; we beseech Thee, through all the services he has rendered to Jesus and Mary on earth, that Thou wouldst make us worthy of his intercession and grant us to enjoy the happiness of his company in heaven. Through Christ our Lord. Amen.
