The Sanctuary Lamp

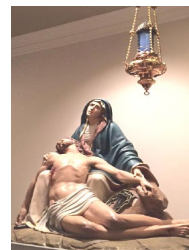


The Sanctuary Lamp burns constantly to proclaim the real presence of our Lord Jesus Christ in the Tabernacle. This week we dedicate the flame to:

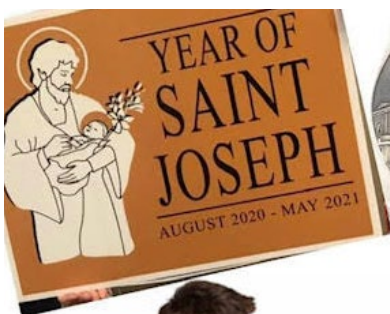

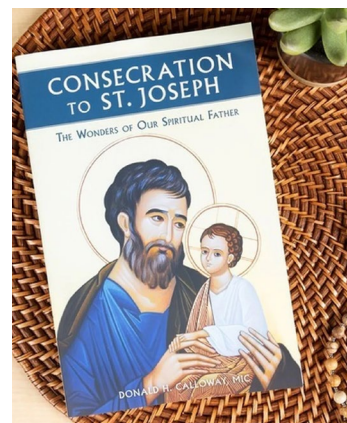

Mrs. Adele Guillot, who possesses a masters degree in theology from Notre Dame Seminary in New Orleans and who is also known as the "Cajun Catechist" (cajuncatechist.com), will be presenting in our parish for 4 consecutive Thursday evenings starting on Oct 29 and ending on Nov 19. Each presentation is from 6-8pm in the Family Life Center.

The presentations are free of charge and open to adult parishioners. Teaching materials will be provided by Mrs. Adele. To Thy sweet yoke our stiff necks bow, warm with Thy fire our hearts of snow, our wandering feet recall.

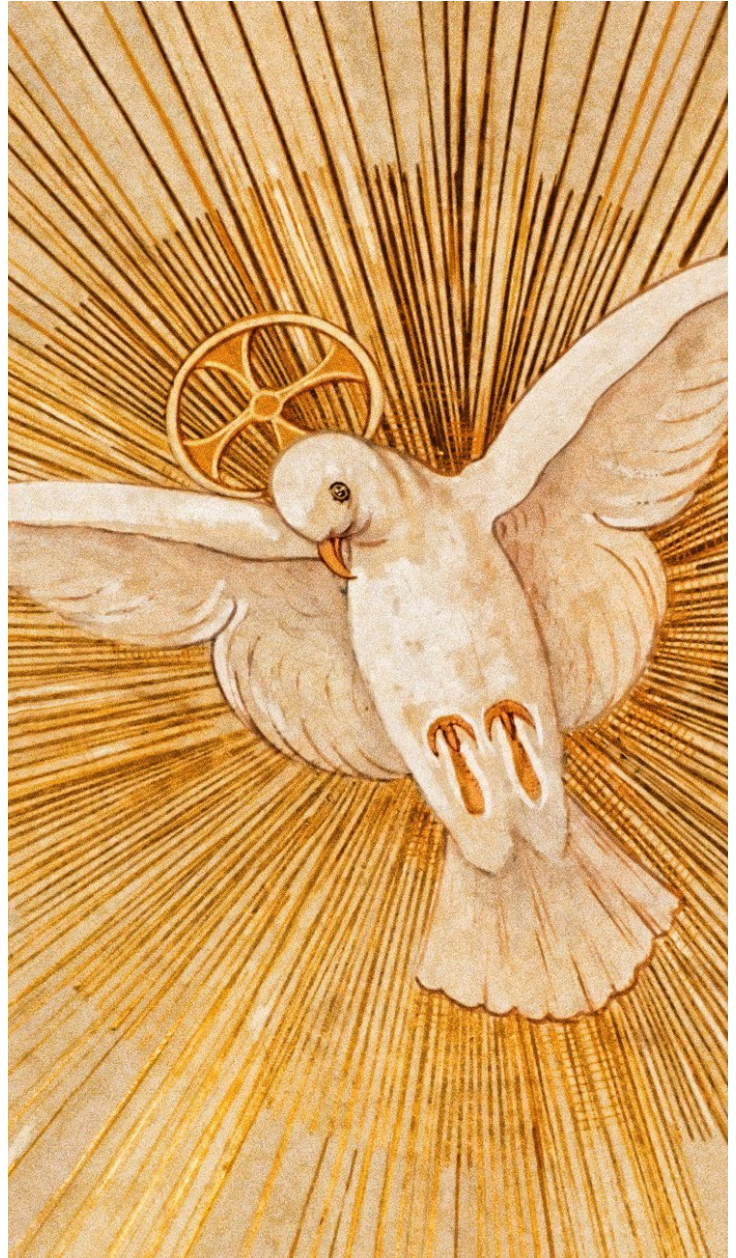
Grant to Thy faithful, dearest Lord, whose only hope is Thy sure word, the sevenfold gifts of grace.
