# Ash Wednesday

The Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments has directed that the following adaptations be made to celebrations of Ash Wednesday this year: The priest will address all those present and only once say the formula "Repent, and believe in the Gospel" or "Remember that you are dust and to dust you shall return."

Then the priest (or a minister) puts on a face mask and distributes ashes to those who come up. The priest (or minister) takes the ashes and sprinkles them on the head of each one without saying anything.


