The Sanctuary Lamp



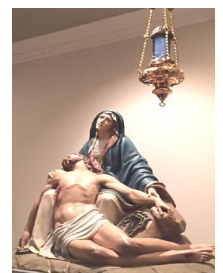

Feeding our Faith returns for a special Lenten series on Tuesday evenings, March 15th, 22nd, and 29th from 6pm to 7:30pm in the Family Life Center.

Each session begins with a free supper followed by a video presentation and discussion. Our video series is entitled "The Hidden King: The Jewish Roots of St. Joseph" by Dr. Brant Pitre.

What is your image of St. Joseph? A poor, humble carpenter, an elderly widower, or a man in his prime, the chaste spouse of Mary?

In this series, Dr. Pitre takes the popular figure of St. Joseph and opens up the mysteries of his hidden identity, his relationship with Mary, and his role as the earthly foster-father of Jesus.

Many books on St. Joseph focus on legends and private revelations. In this Bible study, Dr. Pitre focuses on what we can learn about St. Joseph from the Bible, ancient Jewish and Roman history, and the Living Tradition of the Church. As you will discover, when looked at through ancient Jewish eyes, Joseph stands with Jesus and Mary at the center of salvation history.

Feeding our Faith is offered free of charge so please come and join us as together we unpack the mystery of our Patron, St. Joseph, during this special 150th Anniversary Year of St. Joseph Parish.

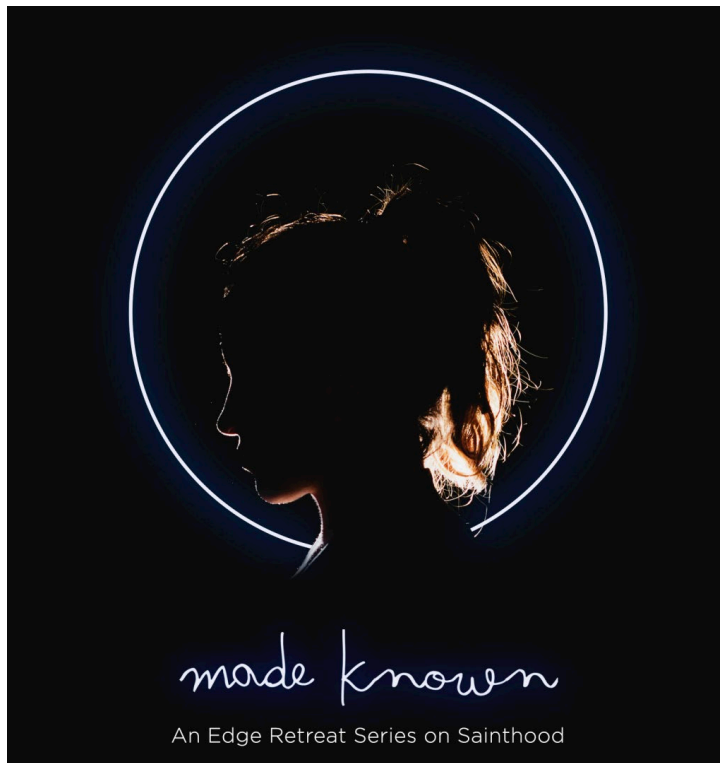
Edge Retreat: Made Known

First Friday Mass & Adoration

The first Friday of the month is often marked by special devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. St. Margaret Mary Alacoque (1647-1690) reported visions of Jesus Christ directing her to promote devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus on nine consecutive First Fridays in reparation for sins and in order to show love to Jesus. In return for this act of devotion, which usually includes Mass, Communion, confession and even an hour of Eucharistic Adoration, our blessed Savior reputedly promised St. Margaret Mary the following blessings:

“In the excess of the mercy of my Heart, I promise you that my all powerful love will grant to all those who will receive Communion on the First Fridays, for nine consecutive months, the grace of final repentance: they will not die in my displeasure, nor without receiving the sacraments; and my Heart will be their secure refuge in that last hour.”

Please join us every first Friday of the month for 6:30am Mass followed by Adoration from 7-8am. Sacred Heart of Jesus, make my heart like yours!
