

Announcing Phase One of Moving the Sacrament of Confirmation to a younger age:

By directive of Bishop Deshotel, starting this Fall of 2023, we will begin the transition of Confirmation in 11th grade to the 8th grade.

We will confirm grades 10 and 11 in the Fall, and grades 8 and 9 in the Spring. Thereafter, everyone will be confirmed in the 8th grade.

Parent meeting for all 10/11th graders seeking Confirmation

Confirmation classes will be held Sept 10 through November 12, 2023.

A total of 10 classes will be held in the Family Life Center every Sunday at 3:30pm-5:15pm.

All participants are encouraged to attend the 5:30pm Sunday mass afterwards.

Once Confirmation preparation is complete, all are encouraged and expected to move on to the Rayne Youth program held on Sundays after the 5:30pm mass

A mandatory retreat will be held on Saturday November 18, 2023 at Camp Karol in Moss Bluff, LA. Transportation will be provided. This will be a one full-day retreat (tentatively scheduled to depart Rayne at 7:30am and return at 9:30pm)

The Confirmation Mass will be Sunday November 19, 2023 at 2pm. There will be a practice before this ceremony, date/time to be announced later.

Fee: \$100

This fee is to offset the costs of the supplies needed for the prep, to hire staff, and pay the expenses of the retreat. If for some reason someone is not able to pay the fee, please contact Fr Brent for assistance.

Kristina Lavergne will be the leader/coordinator of Confirmation prep until we have fully transitioned to the 8th grade. If you have any questions, she can be reached at her email: klavergne@ndpios.com or you can call Fr Brent at the parish office.





First Friday Mass & Adoration

The first Friday of the month is often marked by special devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. St. Margaret Mary Alacoque (1647-1690) reported visions of Jesus Christ directing her to promote devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus on nine consecutive First Fridays in reparation for sins and in order to show love to Jesus. In return for this act of devotion, which usually includes Mass, Communion, confession and even an hour of Eucharistic Adoration, our blessed Savior reputedly promised St. Margaret Mary the following blessings:

"In the excess of the mercy of my Heart, I promise you that my all powerful love will grant to all those who will receive Communion on the First Fridays, for nine consecutive months, the grace of final repentance: they will not die in my displeasure, nor without receiving the sacraments; and my Heart will be their secure refuge in that last hour."

Please join us every first Friday of the month for 6:30am Mass followed by Adoration from 7-8am. Sacred Heart of Jesus, make my heart like yours!
