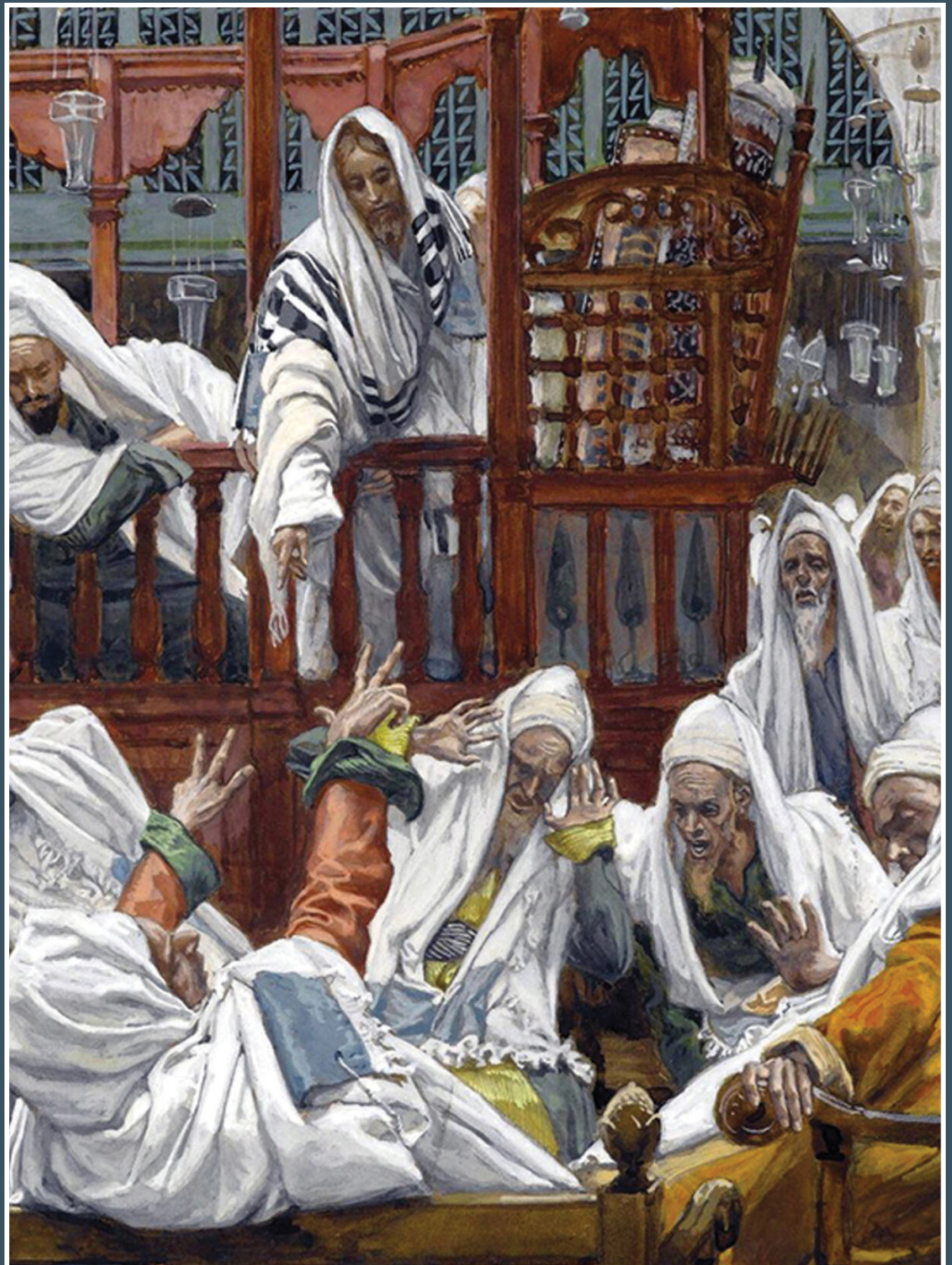

Fr. Blake Dubroc will lead a presentation on Soldiers Making Way for the King on Wednesday, January 31st at 6:30pm in the Family Life Center. All men interested in participating in this Lenten journey are urged to attend.

Inspired by the simple reading of the Gospels and forged through the humble recognition of our weaknesses Soldiers Making Way for the King invites us men to fight for Christ to fill our lives with His leadership. Many men have heard the Church preach the universal call for Holiness and even more men have heard the Holy Spirit calling in the depths of their hearts to give more of themselves, but few men have changed their habits to reveal what all Christians proclaim, that Christ alone is center of their lives. We Christian men rage against the tide of the culture, we run from the lies of Satan, and we fight against our own flesh. Alone and without structure, we compromise with sin and settle for mediocrity in virtue. Hidden in the plain sight of our Church's tradition are the weapons needed to gain our freedom, to claim our place in the Kingdom of Heaven, and to defend our Church. It is the mission of Soldiers Making Way for the King to arm ourselves and our brothers with what Sacred Scripture calls the "two edge Sword," "the breastplate of righteousness," and "the helmet of salvation."

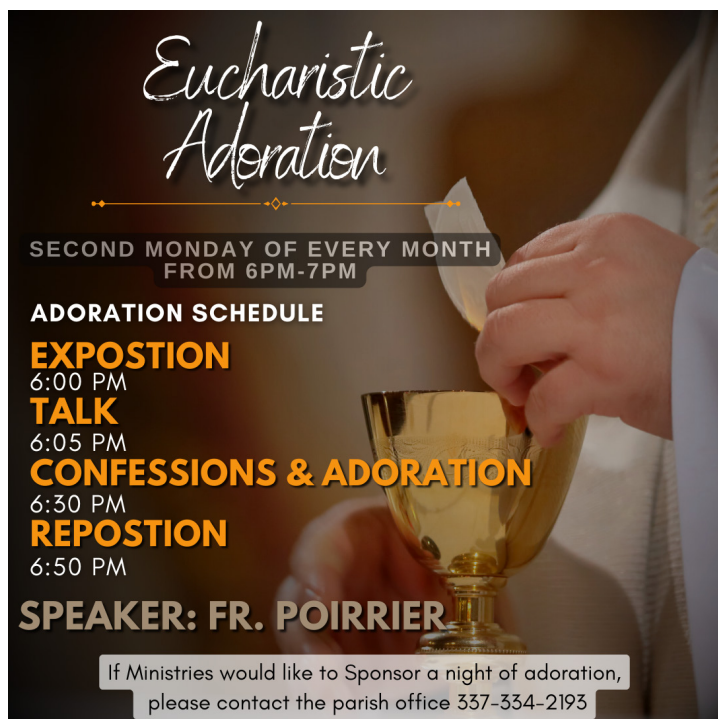

First Friday Mass & Adoration

The first Friday of the month is often marked by special devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. St. Margaret Mary Alacoque (1647-1690) reported visions of Jesus Christ directing her to promote devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus on nine consecutive First Fridays in reparation for sins and in order to show love to Jesus. In return for this act of devotion, which usually includes Mass, Communion, confession and even an hour of Eucharistic Adoration, our blessed Savior reputedly promised St. Margaret Mary the following blessings:

“In the excess of the mercy of my Heart, I promise you that my all powerful love will grant to all those who will receive Communion on the First Fridays, for nine consecutive months, the grace of final repentance: they will not die in my displeasure, nor without receiving the sacraments; and my Heart will be their secure refuge in that last hour.”

Please join us every first Friday of the month for 6:30am Mass followed by Adoration from 7-8am. Sacred Heart of Jesus, make my heart like yours!
