


First Friday Mass & Adoration

The first Friday of the month is often marked by special devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. St. Margaret Mary Alacoque (1647-1690) reported visions of Jesus Christ directing her to promote devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus on nine consecutive First Fridays in reparation for sins and in order to show love to Jesus. In return for this act of devotion, which usually includes Mass, Communion, confession and even an hour of Eucharistic Adoration, our blessed Savior reputedly promised St. Margaret Mary the following blessings: "In the excess of the mercy of my Heart, I promise you that my all powerful love will grant to all those who will receive Communion on the First Fridays, for nine consecutive months, the grace of final repentance: they will not die in my displeasure, nor without receiving the sacraments; and my Heart will be their secure refuge in that last hour." Please join us every first Friday of the month for 6:30am Mass followed by Adoration from 7-8am. Sacred Heart of Jesus, make my heart like yours!





I believe, O Lord, and I confess that Thou art truly the Christ, the Son of the living God, Who camest into the world to save sinners, of whom I am first. I believe also that this is truly Thine own most pure Body, and that this is truly Thine own precious Blood. Therefore, I pray Thee: have mercy upon me and forgive my transgressions both voluntary and involuntary, of word and of deed, committed in knowledge or in ignorance. PARISH FORMATION

Sacrament of Confession

Q - When did Jesus Christ institute the sacrament of penance?

A - After His Resurrection, when He breathed on His disciples and said. "Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven; if you retain the sins of any, they are retained" (Jn 20:22-23).

Q. - What sins are necessary to confess in the sacrament of penance?

A. - All mortal sins that we have committed since baptism and not yet confessed. These sins must be confessed by number and species. We may also confess any venial sins, and it is most advisable to do so.

Q. - May any sins be forgiven by this sacrament?

A. - Yes. No matter how grave our sins and failures, the love of God for us is infinitely greater, and those who truly repent and seek His forgiveness will always find it, for He is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love.

Q- What is the seal of confession?

A. - The strict obligation imposed on priests to maintain inviolable secrecy about everything learned through sacramental confession. Matters discussed within this "tribunal of penance" must be known only to God, the priest as His representative, and the penitent who seeks His mercy.

Q. - What are the effects of the sacrament of penance?

- A. This sacrament: 1. Remits all sins committed after baptism when these are confessed with contrition;
- 2. Remits all eternal punishment due to sin, and temporal punishment in proportion to our dispositions;
- 3. Returns supernatural life to the sinner, and increases it in the just; 4. Restores our lost merits; 5. Confers specific graces for avoiding the sins confessed; 6. Often imparts a sensible peace and serenity of conscience.
