First Friday Mass & Adoration

The first Friday of the month is often marked by special devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. St. Margaret Mary Alacoque (1647-1690) reported visions of Jesus Christ directing her to promote devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus on nine consecutive First Fridays in reparation for sins and in order to show love to Jesus. In return for this act of devotion, which usually includes Mass, Communion, confession and even an hour of Eucharistic Adoration, our blessed Savior reputedly promised St. Margaret Mary the following blessings: "In the excess of the mercy of my Heart, I promise you that my all powerful love will grant to all those who will receive Communion on the First Fridays, for nine consecutive months, the grace of final repentance: they will not die in my displeasure, nor without receiving the sacraments; and my Heart will be their secure refuge in that last hour." Please join us every first Friday of the month for 6:30am Mass followed by Adoration from 7-8am. Sacred Heart of Jesus, make my heart like yours!


- 1. Attend Holy Mass on all Sundays & Holy Days of Obligation.

PILGRIMS OF HOPE

CATHOLICS CAN OBTAIN A PLENARY INDULGENCE DURING THE 2025 JUBILEE YEAR BY:

- <u>Making a pilgrimage</u>: Visit a designated church or basilica, such as St. Peter's Basilica in Rome
- <u>Participating in works of mercy</u>: Support the poor, elderly, migrants, or young people in need
- <u>Fasting</u>: Abstain from "futile distractions" like social media and television
- Donating: Give money to the poor
- Volunteering: Serve your community
- <u>Praying:</u> Pray for the Pope's intentions, such as the Our Father and Hail Mary
- <u>Confessing</u>: Confess your sins within about 20days
- <u>Receiving Communion</u>: Receive the Eucharist, ideally on the same day as the act that earned the indulgence <u>REQUIREMENTS</u>
 - Be in a state of grace
- Be in a state of grace
- Be detached from sin, including venial sin
- Have received Communion
- Have prayed for the Pope's intentions
