First Friday Mass & Adoration

The first Friday of the month is often marked by special devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. St. Margaret Mary Alacoque (1647-1690) reported visions of Jesus Christ directing her to promote devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus on nine consecutive First Fridays in reparation for sins and in order to show love to Jesus. In return for this act of devotion, which usually includes Mass, Communion, confession and even an hour of Eucharistic Adoration, our blessed Savior reputedly promised St. Margaret Mary the following blessings: "In the excess of the mercy of my Heart, I promise you that my all powerful love will grant to all those who will receive Communion on the First Fridays, for nine consecutive months, the grace of final repentance: they will not die in my displeasure, nor without receiving the sacraments; and my Heart will be their secure refuge in that last hour." Please join us every first Friday of the month for 6:30am Mass followed by Adoration from 7-8am. Sacred Heart of Jesus, make my heart like yours!

Baptism



Lenten Mission

Cheryl H. White, Ph.D. is a professor of history at Louisiana State University at Shreveport and a nationally recognized scholar of the Shroud of Turin. She serves on the board of the Shroud of Turin Education and Research Association (STERA) and has conducted original research in the Vatican Secret Archives on the history of the Shroud. Dr. White has presented on the Shroud of Turin at World Youth Day in Lisbon, the National Eucharistic Congress, and at churches and conferences across the United States and internationally. She has served as historical consultant for the Shroud of Turin exhibit at the Museum of the Bible and appears in documentaries and media programs exploring the Shroud.
